



## **Resource Development Report to the Board of Trustees April 2024**

### **Spring Term Scholarships**

The NFC Foundation has received the semester invoice for the Spring 2024 semester, with disbursements totaling **\$130,462.44** for **201 students**. This amount includes general scholarships, pass-through scholarships, and special scholarships such as Operation Outreach, Presidential, and Open House Drawings. The semester invoice for Spring 2024 is currently being processed.

*\*Students may receive more than one scholarship.*

### **High School Senior Season**

After twelve successful high school visits from January to March, the NFC Foundation ended the High School Senior Application period with a total of twenty-four applicants. These applicants will be evaluated to see if they are eligible to receive a scholarship. These scholarship awards will be presented to the seniors at their school's Senior Awards ceremony if the school participates in an award ceremony.

### **Graduation Regalia Scholarship**

For the Spring 2024 semester, the NFC Foundation offered the Graduation Regalia Scholarship as an opportunity for students to have their graduation regalia fees paid for by the NFC Foundation. This was the first time this scholarship application was offered as a regular scholarship.

So far, this scholarship has had four applicants. All four of those applicants were accepted for the graduation regalia scholarship, and we look forward to helping our students with their grad regalia costs in the future.

### **Operation Outreach — Madison County**

As of April 3, 2024, the NFC Foundation has chosen two recipients of the Operation Outreach Scholarship for Madison County. The winners have been notified, and the applicants that were not selected were notified about the High School Senior application so that they had the opportunity to be considered for another type of scholarship if they choose to apply. The deadline for the High School Senior Application was March 30th. We have notified the winners' guidance counselor and have requested to take pictures with the winners for a feature.
