



LPN TO RN Accelerated Bridge Track

72 Credit Hours

The LPN to RN Accelerated Bridge Track is a one year/three semester program leading to an Associate in Science in Registered Nursing for individuals that already have certification and licensure as a practical nurse (LPN).

This is a limited access program. **Applications are accepted March 1-June 1 each year.**

Training can be completed in a year and a half (prerequisites included).

CLASS TIMES: Classes meet two days a week with variable clinical hours.

CERTIFICATION: Successful completion of the LPN to RN Accelerated Bridge Track prepares graduates to take the National Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Achievement of a passing score on this exam and licensure by the Florida State Board of Nursing enables the graduate to seek employment as a Registered Nurse in the state of Florida.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Be in good academic standing if previously or currently enrolled at NFC
2. Basic computer skills
3. Current unencumbered LPN license
4. Documentation from employer of one year of full-time work experience as an LPN at a licensed healthcare facility by completion of program.
5. Satisfactory completion of placement test, college preparatory work, and pre-requisite courses
6. Completion of approved IV Therapy Course
7. Completion of HESI Admission Test
8. Security background screening, drug screen
9. Mandatory orientation session

PROGRAM COST

Total cost is approximately \$6,609.

INCLUDES: tuition, supplies, uniforms, program patches, clinical name badge, books, testing package, state board application fee, and NCLEX testing fee.

- 3 **SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS**
Official transcripts from high school/GED and all previous/current colleges.
- 4 **COMPLETE ASSESSMENT TESTS**
Complete HESI Admission Assessment (approx. \$54) by deadline. Schedule testing with NFC Testing Center, 850.973.9451 or testing@nfc.edu.
- 5 **COMPLETE LPN TO RN BRIDGE APPLICATION**
Complete online LPN to RN Bridge program application by designated deadline.
- 6 **IF ACCEPTED INTO PROGRAM** Completion of background screening (\$60), drug screening (\$45), immunizations and physical information will be required and should be submitted to Tara Mesnard (mesnardt@nfc.edu or 850.973.1626) before program orientation.

Prior to admission in NFC Allied Health Programs, the student must have completed an FDLE, Level II security background investigation. The cost of the security background investigation is the responsibility of the student.


